JOB SUMMARY

Pratt's Painting/Drawing Studio offers beginning and intermediate workshops and classes.

REQUIRED

- Thorough knowledge of drawing or painting related topic, trend, process or skill.
- Prior experience teaching a painting or drawing workshop
- Ability to clearly communicate technical information to students
- Ability to effectively balance demonstration, discussion, and work time
- Ability to create a syllabus that conforms to a set curriculum
- Ability to develop class samples and handouts
- Patience, flexibility, and a sense of humor
- Punctuality, organizational skills, and responsibility
- Willingness to educate self and students on related Pratt programs (eg scholarship opportunities)
- Responsiveness (by email or phone) regarding scheduling, supplies, and paperwork
- Adherence to Pratt policies and studio procedures
- Commitment to fostering a universally welcoming and respectful environment in keeping with Pratt's Code of Conduct and Racial Equity initiative

DESIRED

- Degree in Painting/Drawing or related field
- Ability to provide relevant and high-quality promotional images
- Ability to lend sample objects for promotional displays
- Willingness to promote Pratt classes through personal networks
- Engagement in wider art communities

- Willingness to educate self and students on other Pratt programs and events (eg other departments, Open House, auction)

COMPENSATION / BENEFITS
