JOB SUMMARY

This part-time position works with the Jewelry/Metals Technician and the Jewelry/Metals and Stone Studio Manager, reporting primarily to the Jewelry/Metals Technician. **The primary responsibility is monitoring the Jewelry/Metals Studio during Student Friday Sessions** for students enrolled in weekly Jewelry/Metals classes. Student Friday Sessions are monitored open studio times for students to practice the skills they learned in their classes and time outside of class to work on assigned projects. The chief role of this position is to support the student experience through encouragement, reinforcement of instructor lead learnings, and assisting students with mastering basic skills Must be able to clearly communicate technical information to students while maintaining a safe studio environment. Commitment to fostering a universally welcoming and respectful environment.
