

## TUITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Pratt's mission is to make art accessible to everyone. Pratt raises funds to subsidize the cost of participation and maintain the lowest possible fees for its programs. And yet, there are many who still cannot afford to participate. The Tuition Assistance (TA) program aims to provide a deeper subsidy to those who would not otherwise be able to participate due to financial limitations.

Tuition Assistance is applied as a 75% discount on the class fee for a class of the applicant's choice. TA does not cover supply fees. Applicants are responsible to pay the remaining balance of the class fee as well as any supply fee associated with their chosen class.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

Those whose household income falls at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines (shown below) are eligible for Tuition Assistance. If your household income is SAME or LESS than the amount in the following chart, you are eligible for Tuition Assistance at Pratt Fine Arts Center:

#### **DEFINITIONS:**

\*Household Size: this number includes the applicant, any other individuals who share financial responsibility for the household, and all dependents

\*\*Household Income: the combined gross income generated each year by all household members, as reported on IRS annual income tax forms

#### **EXCEPTIONS**

- Only one TA student is allowed per class, on a first-come, first serve basis.
- TA students do not count towards the minimum enrollment requirement to run a class. If a TA student is enrolled in a class that gets cancelled, the student will be encouraged to reapply in subsequent cycle(s).
- TA is not available for specialty programs such as Study Abroad, Master Artist, or Summer Camp Aftercare programs.
- Students may receive TA a maximum of twice per calendar year.

### **APPLICATION CYCLES**

Tuition Assistance applications are accepted during ten-day periods each time a new schedule of classes is published. Here are the application periods coming up in 2019:

If applying for assistance for Pratt's **2019 Youth Summer Camps** (for ages 5 – 13, start dates from July 8 through Aug 5), students may apply during **any** of the above application periods.

## **HOW TO APPLY**

- 1. Identify the next application period and the eligible date range for classes.
- 2. Choose a preferred class within the proper date range and a back-up choice in case that class is not available.
