### 2018 Summer Youth Art Camps

All youth art camps meet Monday – Friday, 9 am – 3 pm (5 sessions). Camp fee is \$350 per week. After-care is available 3 – 6 pm for \$20 per day.

#### DESCRIPTION Youth Art Camps for Ages 7–9 **SESSION 1** Write and draw your own story! Students will learn to develop an idea and turn it into Comics and a comics page or strip. Explore the art of **Graphic Novels** putting together elements of a comic book: (Ages 7 - 9) panels, balloons, characters, and symbols. 07/09 - 07/13 Using pencils and ink students will explore different ways of telling stories and creating characters, leading up to the creation of a class comic book. **SESSION 2** This camp is all about putting things together and building. They will transform Scissors, Tape drawings into 3 dimensional works of art and Glue while working on concepts like visual Everything balance and narrative. SESSION 1 Comics and Graphic Novels (Ages 10 -12) 07/09 – 07/13	Write and draw your own story! Students will learn to develop an idea and turn it into a comics page or strip. Explore the art of putting together elements of a comic book: panels, balloons, characters, and symbols. Using pencils and ink students will explore different ways of telling stories and creating characters, leading up to the creation of a class comic book.			
SESSION 2 Cave Art to Street Art (Ages 10 -12) 07/16 – 07/20	By studying many types of art and materials, students will make their own classics and monuments. Students will explore perspective, abstraction, and non-western working methods. Each day will have a new project with new materials while students learn about drawing and painting materials.			
SESSION 3 Architecture Out of the Box (Ages 10 - 12) 07/23 - 07/27	Design and create buildings of the future inspired by wild imagination! Students will design and construct a cityscape and outdoor environment using found objects, paint, paper, and glue. Explore techniques such as stamping, collage, construction, papier- mache, painting, and drawing. Students will think outside the box in this week all about construction.			
SESSION 4 Pop Art (Ages 10 - 12) 07/30 - 08/03	Explore drawing, painting and creating 3-dimensional objects in the style of Pop Art. Using images from mass culture and comic books as well as found objects as inspiration, anything goes, even a soup can! Students will create collages, posters, sculptures and much more.			
SESSION 5 Storytelling with Comics (Ages 10 -12) 08/06 - 08/10	Create characters with a focus on storytelling. This camp will analyze a variety of comics and parts of feature films in order to understand character development. With a focus on the art of storytelling students will develop a comic that communicates an idea. Using elements of design students will create finished would with pencils, ink and watercolors to create finished work.
