

Blow Pipe Policies for In-Person Classes

Beginning Glass Blowing Class/Hands-On Experience Class/Youth and Teen Class

Pratt utilizes <u>a pocket inflator</u> to teach blowing technique to beginner students. Students will not directly blow pipes to avoid direct contact with other students. Based on the <u>mask policy</u> at Pratt, students are required to wear a mask during the class.

Intermediate Glass Blowing Class

Instructors teach how to use <u>a blowhose</u> to learn self-blowing technique. Students will stick on designated pipes on that day (No sharing pipes). At the end of the session, students sanitize their pipes to return them to the tool room. Students are encouraged to have their personal blowhoses. Blowhoses are available to purchase at Pratt (\$41). Based on the <u>mask policy</u> at Pratt, students are required to wear a mask during the class.

Advanced Glass Blowing Class

Instructors teach advanced technique with <u>a blowhose</u>. Students will stick on designated pipes on that day (No sharing pipes). At the end of the session, students sanitize the pipes to return them to the tool room. Students are encouraged to have their personal blowhoses. Blowhoses are available to purchase at Pratt (\$41). Based on the <u>mask policy</u> at Pratt, students are required to wear a mask during the class.
